 - > Create a Federal Student Aid ID at www.studentaid.ed.gov/fsaid.
 - > Apply for aid by completing the FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
 - > Malone's FAFSA code is 003072.
 - > Have a copy of all tax returns handy (parents' and student's).
 - > The priority deadline for filing the FAFSA is March 1.

- 3 DETERMINE YOUR MERIT-BASED AID:**
 - > Malone offers scholarships and grants for academics, athletics, music, and leadership positions. View a list of available scholarships and grants at www.malone.edu/scholarships.
 - > Scholarships and grants are available to students based on GPA and ACT/SAT scores.
 - > Awards range from \$6,000 to full tuition and are renewable annually with continued academic progress.




